Our Summer 2022 Workforce Development Construction Job Readiness & Training Program partnership was extremely successful (grant funded by Sac Youth Works, City of Sacramento, Pro Youth & Families). We started with 15 students and 15 students graduated. All were enrolled in SETA (Sacramento Employment Training Agency) through NSBIF (North State Building Industry Foundation) & HEC (Health Education Council) co-enrollment. ABC NorCal (Assoc. Builders & Contractors, Inc.) partnered w/OSHA 10 & Tools.

ALL GRADUATES HAVE HIGHER PAYING JOB OPTIONS BECAUSE OF ENHANCED SKILLS.



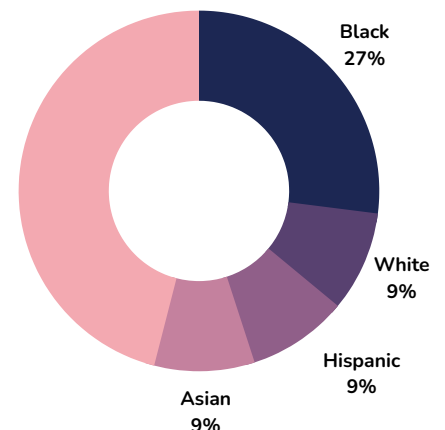
