

Garden Party



The Three Sisters Gardens (TSG) is one of five urban farms located in previously vacant lots across West Sacramento. Although considered, an urban food desert area, TSG's four urban farms staffed mostly by volunteers that grow, maintain, and provide healing community learning opportunities across their four farm sites. The produce grown is sold below market rates or provided at no cost to local families. Urban farms are an important strategy to create greater access to fresh fruits and vegetables in the Bryte and Broderick communities.

Three Sisters requested funds to increase awareness of their farm and its available produce. They proposed to host a COVID safe outdoor event to bring people to the farm, teach them about sustainable farming, while also creating a positive and safe space for the

community to connect.

Though the event attendance was less than anticipated, their hope is that those who came will share the knowledge and inspire more residents to engage in working to improve the community's access to healthy food. Three Sisters is not discouraged by the turnout, rather hope to do host more community events and incorporate lessons learned such as holding the event on the weekend and including more hands on activities.
